## David Roberts Honored by UTHSCSA

David Louis Roberts, DDS, general dentist from Dallas, was honored recently at a banquet held by the Department of General Dentistry of the University of Texas Health Science Center Dental School at San Antonio (UTHSCSA). He was selected for this honor from among all former residents of the two postdoctoral programs sponsored by the Department of General Dentistry and is the first resident to be so honored. To date, almost 200 residents have graduated from the programs in the department. Dr. Roberts attended the two-year General Practice Residency (GPR) at the Health Science Center in years 1985-87. The GPR program trains general dentists to provide complex dental care to patients, especially patients with moderate to severe medically compromising conditions. In addition to his standard training activities, Dr. Roberts served as Chief Resident during his second year of postdoctoral training.

In addition to his selection because of his many recognized professional contributions to the practice of dentistry and to the

Department of General Dentistry, Dr. Roberts was recognized also for his work in preserving the scope of practice for general dentists in Texas. The honor includes a bronze plaque now installed in the Department's Dental School graduate clinic and a duplicate plaque awarded to Dr. Roberts. The wording on the plaque reads: "In Honor and Appreciation of David L. Roberts, D.D.S. for His Support of General Dentistry, June, 2003, UTHSCSA". Attendees included Dr. Roberts' wife Kristal, and many colleagues and mentors from his residency days as well as the current faculty and residents of the postdoctoral programs.

Dr. Roberts continues his association with the postdoctoral programs at the Dental School. He regularly travels to San Antonio to lecture to residents and present to faculty of the programs.
